

General Safety Information

- Before installing, servicing, or performing routine maintenance upon this equipment, follow these general precautions.
- Commercial installation, service and maintenance of luminaires should be performed by a qualified licensed electrician.
- For Residential installation: If you are unsure about the installation or maintenance of the luminaires, consult a qualified licensed electrician and check your local electrical code.
- DO NOT INSTALL DAMAGED PRODUCT!
- This fixture is intended to be connected to a properly installed and grounded UL listed junction box.

WARNING:

RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK

- Turn off the electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring fixture to power supply.
- Turn off the power when you perform any maintenance.
- Verify that supply voltage is correct by comparing it with the luminaire label information.
- Make all electrical and grounded connections in accordance with the National Electrical Code and any applicable local code requirements.
- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.

CAUTION:

RISK OF INJURY

- Wear gloves and safety glasses at all times when removing luminaire from carton, installing, servicing or performing maintenance.
- Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while it is on.
- Account for small parts and destroy packing material, as these may be hazardous to children.

CAUTION:

RISK OF FIRE

- Keep combustible and other materials that can burn away from luminaire and lamp/lens.
- MIN 90°C SUPPLY CONDUCTORS.


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Wiring Diagram

▲ WARNING


All units must be individually connected to the AC supply: Select appropriate access point for your installation, remove knockout and feed power leads through hole. Connect the supply wire from the source to the driver.

Caution: Disconnect connection box from branch circuit before installing





MaxLite®

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1. Take the fixture out of the box. Remove the acrylic lens (17) from the fixture and place aside on a flat surface to avoid damage to the lens. To remove the lens, please refer to the label stuck on the end cap. Pull this end cap outward and then remove the acrylic lens from the fixture. (See Figure 1).




2. Position your fixture over the Outlet Box (1). Mark the location of the four Keyhole Slots (11) located on the Fixture Body (12). Be sure to mark only the narrow parts of the Keyhole Slots (11). Remove the Fixture Body (12) from the ceiling. Drill the four holes using the appropriately sized drill bit. Insert the provided Ceiling Anchors (6) into the holes.

- 3. Make the wiring connections: connect the House Ground Wire (2) to the Fixture Ground Wire (9) using Wire Connector (7) (not provided); connect the White Supply Wire (3) to the White Fixture Wire (8); connect Black Supply Wire (4) to the Black Fixture Wire (10) using Wire Connectors (7). Carefully tuck all wires back into the Outlet Box (1).
- **4.** Feed the four Anchor Screws (14) through the narrow part of the Keyhole Slots (11). Tighten the Anchor Screws (14) into the Ceiling Anchors (6) until the Fixture Body (12) is flush with the ceiling.
- **5.** Install the LED LAMP (16) into the Sockets (13). Please follow the wattage label located on the fixture body. Do not exceed the recommend wattage.
- 6. To install the lens, carefully slide the lens to the end cap which is fixed making sure the lens is way to the end of the end cap. Pull the other end cap which is moveable outward and put the lens down. Then the lens will be hold by the end cap.
